

ORDINANCE

79 - 1

AN ORDINANCE relating to the leasing of property for use as an animal shelter.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF MADISON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

WHEREAS: The Kentucky Revised Statutes mandate that the Fiscal Court of each County provide a dog pound for the keeping of stray animals; and

WHEREAS: Richard Snowden has agreed to lease to the County an animal shelter and tract of ground situated on U. S. 25, between Richmond and Berea for a term of three (3) years beginning January 1, 1979, for a monthly rental of ~~two~~^{seven} HUNDRED AND FIFTY (\$750.00) DOLLARS.

NOW, THEREFORE: The Madison County Fiscal Court is authorized to enter into a lease with Richard Snowden wherein the County may lease for a term of three (3) years, Snowden's property on U. S. 25, between Berea and Richmond, for use as an animal shelter. The rental shall be paid and budgeted out of County funds either general fund or revenue sharing, or both, whichever the Fiscal Court deems appropriate.
