

ORDINANCE # 81-9

WHEREAS, the Madison County City-County Ambulance Service has requested that if sufficient funds remained unspent at the end of the fiscal year 80-81, that the original allocation be restored to the Madison County Ambulance Service for operational expenses, and

WHEREAS, at the end of fiscal year 80-81, surplus funds were determined available and the amount of \$ 19,500.00 may be restored to the ambulance service minus the ambulance service amount of workmens compensation insurance due to the County of Madison, which is \$ 5,298.09, and

WHEREAS, the ambulance board has also asked to have the allocation for fiscal year 81-82 restored, which is \$ 11,922.00,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Madison County Fiscal Court that the annual budget for 1981-82 be amended as follows:

INCREASE RECEIPTS of the General Fund by \$ 26,123.91 to include unanticipated revenue from Surplus Funds.

INCREASE BUDGET EXPENDITURES line item # 45-E-1 (Contributions to Madison County Ambulance Service) by \$ 26,123.91 to be disbursed quarterly along with their Federal Revenue Sharing allotment.
