

ORDINANCE # 81-10

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND AMENDMENT THEREOF:

Upon a motion made by Edward S. Chenault and seconded by Farris Parks in reference to the annual budget cut for the Madison Airport Board, the Fiscal Court has agreed to restore the allocation to its original amount. The Court agreed to do this if surplus funds were available at the end of the fiscal year.

It being determined the funds are available, an ordinance is necessary to amend the budget for this fiscal year.

WHEREAS, the Madison County Airport Board needs the additional \$ 750.00 for a ramp at the airport site, and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court agreed to restore the allocation to the airport board, and

WHEREAS, a budget amendment is necessary to set up in the annual budget for fiscal year 1981-82 an allocation to provide funds for this transaction,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Madison County Fiscal Court that the annual budget for 1981-82 be amended as follows:

INCREASE RECEIPTS of the General Fund by \$ 750.00 to include unanticipated revenue from Surplus Funds.

INCREASE BUDGET EXPENDITURES line item # 70-C-7F, (Contributions to Madison Airport Board) by \$ 750.00.

COUNTY ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 81-11

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ADOPTION OF THE KENTUCKY BUILDING CODE AS PROMULGATED IN 815 KAR 7:010, 7:020 AND 7:030 BY THE BOARD OF HOUSING, BUILDINGS AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY.

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WHEREAS, KRS 198B.110]1[, requires that all buildings constructed in Madison County shall be built in conformance with the uniform state building code as adopted by the Board of Housing, Buildings and construction, effective no later than August 15, 1981; and,

WHEREAS, KRS 67.380, KRS 67.410 and KRS 198B.110 authorize the Fiscal Court of Madison Co. of the Commonwealth of Kentucky to adopt the Kentucky Building Code prior to the required effective date, as well as provide for the administration of said code; and,

WHEREAS, KRS 198B.010[5] authorizes any city, county or urban county government to extend, by ordinance, the application of the Kentucky Building Code to single family dwellings.

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SECTION ONE

THAT, the Kentucky Building Code as promulgated in 815 KAR 7:010, 7:020 and 7:030 by the Board of Housing, Buildings and Construction, Commonwealth of Kentucky, is hereby adopted in full as an Ordinance of Madison County of the Commonwealth of Kentucky as if set out at length herein;

THAT, a copy of said Kentucky Building Code together with a copy of all other regulations or NFPA pamphlets adopted or referred to thereunder, is on file in the Office of the Madison County Clerk, and the Clerk shall at all times keep a copy of said building code for reference;

THAT, an attested copy of this Ordinance shall be transmitted to the Department of Housing, Buildings and Construction of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

SECTION TWO

THAT, James R. McKinney, Chief of Madison County Fire Department, shall be designated as the local enforcement agent/agency for said Kentucky Building Code.

SECTION THREE

THAT, all ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR

THAT, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published and recorded according to law.
