

ORDINANCE # 82-2

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Annual Budget and Amendment thereof for Fiscal Year 1981-1982:

WHEREAS, the County of Madison has received unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$55,000.00 from ~~Road Aid Funds~~ for Fiscal Year 1981-1982, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for Madison County to amend its annual budget and to allot this sum of \$55,000.00 to the ~~Turnpike Fund~~ in said budget, *Local Government Economic Assistance Fund 3/19/82*

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordered by the Madison County Fiscal Court that the annual budget be amended as follows:

A. Increase Estimated Receipts in Line Item No. 17 in the LGEA Fund; and

B. Increase budget expenditures in Account No. 508-3 LGEA Fund in the amount of \$55,000.00.
