ORDINANCE NO. 82-5

AN ORDINANCE Relating to the Annual Budget and Amendment Thereof.

Whereas the County of Madison has received revenues from General Fund-Surplus.

IT IS ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF MADISON COUNTY THAT:

SECTION ONE: The annual budget for Fiscal Year 1981-82 is amended to:

- (a) Increase receipts of the Animal Shelter Fund by \$25,000 to include revenues from General Fund-Surplus.
- (b) Increase budget expenditures account number 34-B-2 by \$25,000.

SECTION TWO: The sum added to budget expenditure account(s) in SECTION ONE is appropriated for general governmental purposes.
