

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Annual Budget and Amendment Thereof.

Whereas the County of Madison has received unanticipated revenues from Mineral and Coal Severance Tax.

IT IS ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF MADISON COUNTY THAT:

Section one: The annual budget for fiscal year 1981-82 is amended to:

- (a) Increase receipts of the L.G.E.A. Fund by \$45,745.00 to include unanticipated revenues from Mineral and Coal Severance Tax.
- (b) Increase budget expenditures account number:

508-3 by \$45,745.00

Section two: The sum added to budget expenditure account in Section one appropriated for general governmental purposes.
