 Ordinance No. 84-2

AN ORDINANCE relating to Prohibited activities on Election Day (KRS 117.235)

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court wishes to establish electioneering policies on Election Day.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY OF MADISON, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

That pursuant to KRS 117.235 (3) electioneering shall be permitted throughout Madison County with exception that no electioneering shall be allowed within a fifty (50) foot permitting of a voting machine. Electioneering shall include the displaying of signs, the distribution of campaign literature, cards or handbills, the solicitation of signatures, to any petition, or the solicitation of votes for or against any candidate or question on the ballot in any manner.


EXECUTIVE ORDER 94-5
