

ORDINANCE 85-1

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MADISON COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT NUMBER ONE IN MADISON COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court is aware of the urgent need for adequate sewerage facilities in the Reed's Crossing/Highway 52 East/Estonia area of Madison County and,

WHEREAS, the freeholders of the area have petitioned the court to form a sanitation district pursuant to the authority under KRS 67.615 (2) as treated in KRS 220.030 to 220.552, and,

WHEREAS, due notice has been given of the Fiscal Court's intention to create a sanitation district, and,

WHEREAS, no exceptions have been filed of said notice of intent,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Madison County, Kentucky as follows:

- (1) The County Judge/Executive with the approval of the Fiscal Court, hereby establishes the Madison County Sanitation District Number One.
- (2) The sanitation district is to provide for the collection and disposal of sewage and other liquid wastes produced within the district; and incident to such purposes and to enable their accomplishment, to construct, with all appurtenances thereto, laterals, trunk sewers, intercepting sewers, siphons, pumping stations, treatment and disposal works, to maintain, operate and repair same, and do all other things necessary for the fulfillment of the purposes of KRS 220.010 to 220.520 incorporated herein by reference.
- (3) The boundaries of the Sanitation District Number One are described as follows:

starting at a point at the center of intersection of new Kentucky 52 East highway at the city limits of Richmond; thence due east until it reaches Bluegrass Ordinance Northern boundary, thence with said northern boundary in an easterly direction for the southern boundary of the sewer district until a point 3.5 miles east on New Kentucky Highway 52 from beginning point; thence north 3/4 of a mile from a point in the center of said highway 52; thence in a westerly direction following New Highway 52 almost 3/4 of a mile due north from the center of said highway; until a point 3/4 of a mile due north of the beginning point; thence in a southerly direction 3/4 of a mile to the beginning point. This description is to be construed to exclude any area within the city limits of Richmond.

(4) This ordinance shall become effective when adopted and published as required by law.
