

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Annual Budget and Amendment thereof.

WHEREAS the county of MADISON has received unanticipated revenues from LGEA - Minerals tax.

IT IS ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF MADISON COUNTY THAT:

SECTION ONE: The annual budget for fiscal year ~~1983-84~~ <sup>1984-85</sup> is amended to:

(a) Increase receipts of the LGEA fund by \$ 60,000 to include unanticipated revenue from LGEA FUNDS.

(b) Increase budget expenditures account number:

508-3 by \$ 60,000 for road materials
