

ORDINANCE 86-9

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CREATION OF AN AMBULANCE SERVICE DISTRICT FOR MADISON COUNTY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of the County of Madison, Commonwealth of Kentucky, that the Madison County Fiscal court does hereby create pursuant to KRS 108.105 an ambulance service district and an ambulance service tax of 6 cents per one hundred of full assessed valuation.

The Ambulance Service District shall be county-wide and a county-wide tax will be collected in the manner provided for in KRS 108.100(4) and shall be used solely for the maintenance and operation of a county-wide ambulance service district.

Pursuant to KRS 108.110 the affairs of the ambulance service district shall be operated by a board of directors as set forth therein. The board shall have the power to join other ambulance service districts as approved by the board of directors.

This ordinance shall become effective when adopted and published as required by law.

Done at Richmond, Kentucky, this the 16th day of December, 1986.
