

ORDINANCE 87-8

AN ORDINANCE relating to the creation of a public library district.

WHEREAS, a properly certified petition and plan of service requesting the formation of a public library district to have the authority to impose a special ad valorem tax of three and one-half cents (3.5¢) on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) worth of property assessed for local taxation in Madison County was presented to the Madison County Fiscal Court on September 15, 1987, and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the fiscal court and noticed according to law on October 27, 1987, and,

WHEREAS, the members of the Madison County Fiscal Court have rendered Findings of Fact according to law and have directed that a public library district be formed,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Madison County Fiscal Court, Commonwealth of Kentucky, that the Madison County Fiscal Court does hereby create pursuant to K.R.S. 65.182 et. seq. and K.R.S. 173.450 et. seq. a public library district which shall have the authority to impose a special ad valorem tax of three and one-half cents (3.5¢) on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) worth of property assessed for local taxation in Madison County, Kentucky, to provide all Madison County residents with access to public library services, including establishing, equipping, maintaining, and administering a county public library system.

The public library district for Madison County shall be county-wide, and a county-wide tax shall be collected in the manner provided for in K.R.S. 65.182 and other applicable law and shall be used solely for the operation of a public library district.

Pursuant to K.R.S. 173.450 et. seq., the affairs of the public library district shall be operated by a board of trustees as set forth by statute.

This ordinance shall become effective when adopted and published as required by law.
