A Joint Resolution of the Madison County Fiscal Court,
City of Richmond, Kentucky, and City of Berea, Kentucky.

A JOINT RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A
COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
A 911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SERVICE WITHIN MADISON COUNTY,
KENTUCKY, THE CITY OF RICHMOND, KENTUCKY, AND THE CITY OF
BEREA, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court, the City
Commission of the City of Richmond, Kentucky, and the City
Council of the City of Berea, Kentucky, all have received
information from sources concerning the enhancement of the
health, safety and welfare of the general public by having
available an emergency telephone service; and

WHEREAS, KRS 65.750-.760 permits city and county
governments in the Commonwealth of Kentucky to establish
911 emergency telephone service; and

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court, the City
Commission of the City of Richmond, Kentucky and the City
Council of the City of Berea, Kentucky, are interested in
the possibility of the establishment of a 911 emergency
telephone service to meet the emergency phone needs of the
Madison County area;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Fiscal Court of
the County of Madison, Commonwealth of Kentucky, by the
City Commission of the City of Richmond, Kentucky, and the
City Council of the City of Berea, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION 1

There is hereby established an Emergency Services
Committee which shall be constituted as follows: Madison

County Fiscal Court, Richmond City Commission, and the Berea City Council shall each provide one representative; the Madison County Judge-Executive, the Mayor of the City of Richmond, and the Mayor of the City of Berea shall each appoint one emergency services officer (e.g. fire or police); and each government, acting jointly through its executive and legislative branch, shall appoint one citizen member. The Committee shall also include a representative of the Kentucky State Police and of the Madison County Ambulance Service. Advisory members to the Committee shall include the Madison County Sheriff, one representative each from the Pattie A. Clay Hospital, the Berea Hospital, the Madison County Civil Defense, and the Bluegrass Army Depot.

SECTION II

The Emergency Services Committee shall conduct a study into the feasibility of establishing a 911 emergency telephone service for Madison County and the cities of Richmond and Berea; consider how same shall be implemented; consider the cost of same and how such costs shall be defrayed; and consider any other relevant concerns in the establishment of said 911 emergency telephone service. The Committee shall make a report including recommendations to the respective government bodies by January 30, 1990.

SECTION III

This resolution shall become effective upon enactment by the three legislative bodies herein.
