RESOLUTION TO APPLY

WHEREAS, on this 25th day of May, 1990, the County of Madison recognizes the threat to the public health of malfunctioning private septic tank and sewage treatment systems, many of which have been demonstrated to be contaminating surface and ground water; and

WHEREAS, the County of Madison has determined that it is in the public interest to promote the extension of sanitary sewer service to areas of rural Madison County if and as such extensions should prove feasible; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Madison County Fiscal Court authorizes the filing of a HUD Community Development Block Grant application, for the purpose of extending sanitary sewer service to the Madison County Sanitation District No. 1.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that Judge/Executive George W. Robbins be authorized to sign any and all HUD CDBG application materials.

It is expressly understood that Farmers Home Administration grant and/or loan funds and Kentucky Infrastructure Authority Federally-Assisted Wastewater Revolving Loan funds are being requested by the Madison County Sanitation District No. 1 to partially finance the project. The sum of the funds referred to above shall constitute the major portion of the non-HUD CDBG funds.
