

COUNTY ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 91-07

FOR VOLUNTEER INSPECTION OF ONE AND TWO FAMILY DWELLINGS TO BE INSPECTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE DWELLING CODE.

WHEREAS, Madison County, Kentucky did adopt by ordinance the Kentucky Building Code as it applies to commercial properties excepting one and two family dwellings, and said ordinance did authorize the extension to include one and two family dwellings and,

WHEREAS, the Madison County Fiscal Court does now want to include one and two family dwellings on a volunteer basis, by separate ordinance in accordance with the Kentucky One and Two Family Dwelling Code. Said inspection shall be voluntarily made upon request and the inspection shall be done by the building inspector under the supervision of the Fire Chief of Madison County and all fees to be set by the Madison County Fiscal Court.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF MADISON COUNTY:

SECTION ONE

THAT, inspection to one and two family dwellings be made voluntarily upon request in accordance with the One and Two Family Dwelling Code.

SECTION TWO

THAT, a copy of said code will be kept on file at the office of the County Judge/Executive and at the Madison County Fire Department.

SECTION THREE

THAT, a duly employed certified building inspector shall make all inspections under the supervision of the Fire Chief.

SECTION FOUR

Any and all fees must be set by the Fiscal Court.

SECTION FIVE

THAT, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed,  
published and recorded according to law.
