

AN ORDINANCE Relating to the Annual Budget and Amendment Thereof.

WHEREAS the County of Madison has received unbudgeted revenues from Unanticipated Revenues.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF Madison COUNTY THAT:

SECTION ONE. The annual budget for fiscal year 1991-1992 is amended to:

- a) Increase the receipts of the Jail Fund(s) by \$ 100,000 to include unbudgeted revenues from State Prisoners Controlled Intake and Medical Revenues.
- b) Increase revenue account(s)
