

ORDINANCE NO. 99-27

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ABANDONMENT OF COUNTY ROADS

*BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF MADISON COUNTY,
COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:*

WHEREAS, according to KRS 178.155, any road accepted into the county road system prior to July 1, 1914, which has not been maintained with county funds on a continuous basis for 15 years shall not be considered a part of the county road system, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the same statute, a county may not maintain or improve such roads with county funds; and

WHEREAS, according to the county records, there are a number of roads presently listed in the county road system which were accepted prior to July 1, 1914, which have not been maintained for a continuous 15 year period; and

WHEREAS, those roads meeting the above criteria should not be listed in the official records of the Madison County Road System.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Madison County Fiscal Court, Commonwealth of Kentucky

1. That based upon the official county records and upon information provided by Leroy Brock, Madison County Road Supervisor, the following roads (or sections thereof) were accepted into the Madison County road system prior to July 1, 1914, and have not been maintained with county funds for a continuous 15 year period:

THE ROADS OR SECTIONS THEREON AS REFERENCED SHOWN ON
THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A"

2. That pursuant to applicable state statute, these roads shall not be considered part of the county road system.

3. That no county funds nor resources may be expended to maintain or improve said roads.

4. That the Madison County road department shall take such action necessary to delete the roads from the official Madison County road system.

THIS ORDINANCE NO. 99-27 SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON THE DATE OF THE SECOND READING AND ADOPTION.
