

ORDINANCE 07-02

This ordinance approves a resolution (12-06) by the Board of Commissioners of the Northern Madison Sanitation District that addresses the sewer rate structure for the customers of the Northern Madison County Sanitation District that includes Greens Crossing, Madison Village, Boones Trace, Battlefield and Shiloh Pointe. The rate structure for all customers of the NMCSD will be as follows: First 280 cubic feet - \$30.00 ; next 255 cubic feet - \$2.75 per 100 cubic feet; next 365 cubic feet - \$4.00 per 100 cubic feet; all over 900 cubic feet - \$5.50 per 100 cubic feet. The first 6 months the maximum amount for sewage will not exceed \$45.00 per month.

This Ordinance No. 07-02 shall become effective on the date of the second reading and adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. 12-06

**RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE
NORTHERN MADISON COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT
ESTABLISHING A SEWAGE RATE BASED ON USAGE**

WHEREAS, the Northern Madison County Sanitation District is mandated by different funding agencies to establish a sewer rate that is adequate to meet the cost of operations, maintenance and loan re- payment of the system; and

WHEREAS, the Northern Madison County Sanitation District has determined, with assistance from Rural Development and the Districts Engineering Firm, the needed revenue to meet the requirements from these different funding agencies; and

WHEREAS, the sewage rate needed will be fair and equal to all residential customers within the Northern Madison County Sanitation District, this rate is determined to be a usage base rate; and

WHEREAS, the Northern Madison County Sanitation District rate structure at this present time is a flat monthly fee for the systems at Adams Pointe, Battlefield, Boones Trace, Madison Village, and Shiloh Pointe, with the exception of Greens Crossing which is already a usage base rate; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Northern Madison County Sanitation District have reviewed current rates and have by passage of this resolution agreed to establish this needed Usage Base Rate:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it duly **RESOLVED** as follow:


To recommend to the Madison County Fiscal Court that all residential customers served by Northern Madison County Sanitation District have the following rate structure beginning February 2007:


First 280 Cubic Feet	\$30.00
Next 255 Cubic Feet	\$2.75 per 100 Cubic Feet
Next 365 Cubic Feet	\$4.00 per 100 Cubic Feet
All over 900 Cubic Feet	\$5.50 per 100 Cubic Feet


The Board of Commissioners have agreed to a transition period that will allow time for current residential customers to adjust to this new usage base rate, the Commissioners have agreed that during the first 6 months the maximum amount for sewage will not exceed \$45.00 per month.

* The proposed monthly charge for 4,000 residential usage will be \$37.00 per month
