MADISON COUNTY, KY  
ORDINANCE 20-02**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN TRUCKS  
USING DESIGNATED COUNTY STREETS AND ROADWAYS FOR THROUGH  
TRAFFIC OR THROUGH STREETS AND ROADS**

**WHEREAS**, the Madison County Fiscal Court is responsible for the maintenance of Madison County roadways; and

**WHEREAS**, certain types of overweight vehicles place additional stress on road systems that were not intended for such a weight; and

**WHEREAS**, reducing weight on roadways will reduce damage to, and destruction of, county roadways and will preserve the integrity of county roadways; and

**WHEREAS**, preservation of county roadways provides for public safety and convenience on county highways;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Fiscal Court of the County of Madison, Commonwealth of Kentucky, the following:

Section 1: Between the hours of 5:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m., it shall be prohibited for any Semitrailer, Truck tractor, or Trailer, as defined by KRS §189.010, to use county roadways and streets designated by the Madison County Fiscal Court herein, or as hereafter designated by said Fiscal Court, to be used as, or for the purpose of, thru traffic or as a thru street or road, except that such designated trucks may use designated streets and roads if said streets and roads are necessary for a delivery or pick up of goods, materials, or merchandise to a resident, owner or property which requires the use of said designated street or road to make or complete such a delivery or pick up. This Ordinance shall not prohibit any use authorized under 603 KAR 5:250, governing reasonable access to National Truck Network highways.

Section 2: The county streets and roads designated by the Madison County Fiscal Court as streets and road which are subject to the prohibition described in Section 1 are attached hereto as Attachment A

Section 3: Any person, corporation, or other legal entity who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than \$10.00 or more than 500.00 per violation.

**THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON THE DATE OF THE SECOND READING AND ADOPTION.**
