## INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

### AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SIGNATURE OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR RESCUE AND EXTRICATION SERVICES BETWEEN MADISON COUNTY FISCAL COURT AND MADISON COUNTY EMS

**WHEREAS**, the Madison County EMS requires rescue and extraction services to perform their role as first responders; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance to 202 KAR 7:550 EMS may execute an agreement with a subcontractor for extrication; and

**WHEREAS**, the Madison County EMS wishes to secure Madison County Fire Department for rescue and extrication services; and

**WHEREAS**, this Interlocal Agreement is entered into for the mutual benefit of the parties, and is specifically authorized by the Interlocal Cooperation Act set forth in KRS §65.210 et seq.

#### **NOW THEREFORE IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PROMISES AND AGREEMENTS CONTAINED HEREIN, IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. On request of the EMS for County response by notification of the Madison County Joint 911 Dispatch Center, County firefighting and extrication equipment and personnel of the requested entity will be dispatched when available to any point within the Madison County Fire Rescue Response Area.
2. The rendering of assistance under the terms of this agreement shall be mandatory, but the party receiving the request for assistance shall immediately inform the requesting department, if for any reason, assistance cannot be rendered.
3. The County shall provide 24-hour service at no cost to EMS.
4. Any dispatch of equipment and personnel pursuant to this agreement is subject to the following conditions:
  - a. Any request for aid under this agreement will specify the location to which the equipment and personnel are to be dispatch; however, the amount and type of equipment and number of personnel to be furnished will be determined by a representative of the responding agency.
  - b. The County will report to the officer in charge of the requesting organization at the location to which the equipment is dispatched.
  - c. The County will be released by the requesting organization when the services of EMS, or when EMS is needed within the area for which it normally provides fire protection.
5. Each party hereby waives all claims against the other party for compensation for any loss, damage, injury or death occurring as a consequence of the performance of this agreement.

6. This agreement shall become effective upon the date hereof and remain in full force and effect until cancelled by mutual agreement of the parties hereto or by written notice by one party to the other party, giving thirty (30) days' notice of said cancellation.

7. All parties entering into this agreement will ensure their departmental contact information is kept current with the other department.


8. Within ten (10) days of full execution of this Agreement, a copy thereof shall be recorded by County and Madison County EMS in accordance with Kentucky law.


9. This Agreement and any attachments/schedules constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior agreements or understandings as to the subject matter herein. Any modifications or amendments to this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be signed by each party.
